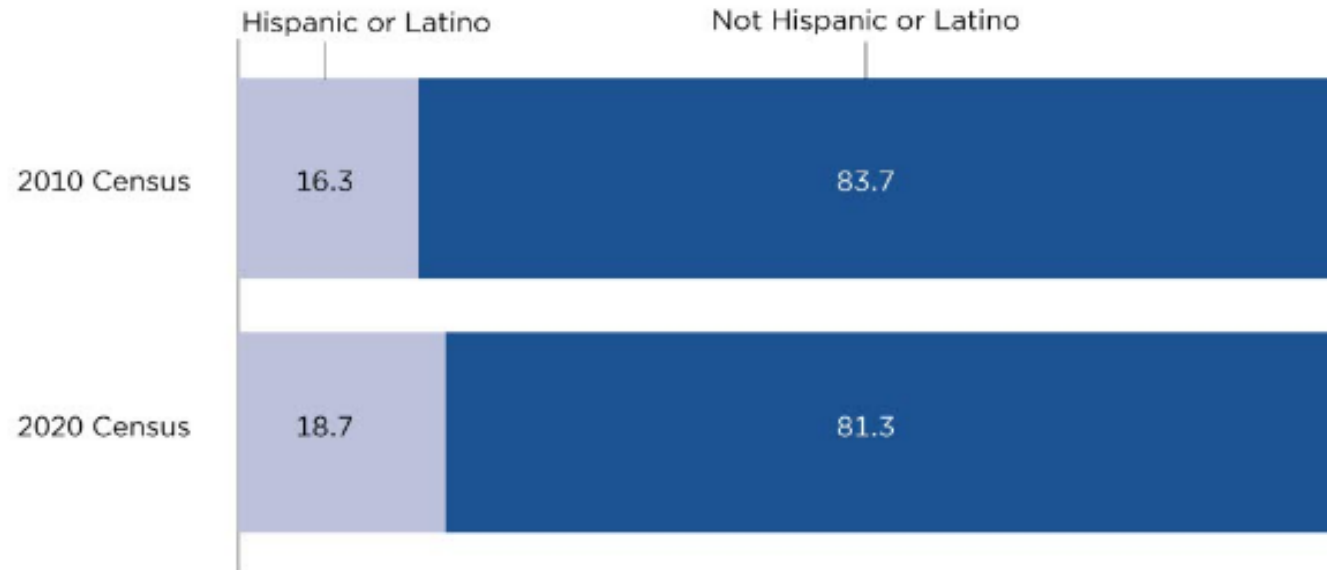

Percentage Distribution of the Hispanic or Latino Population: 2010 and 2020

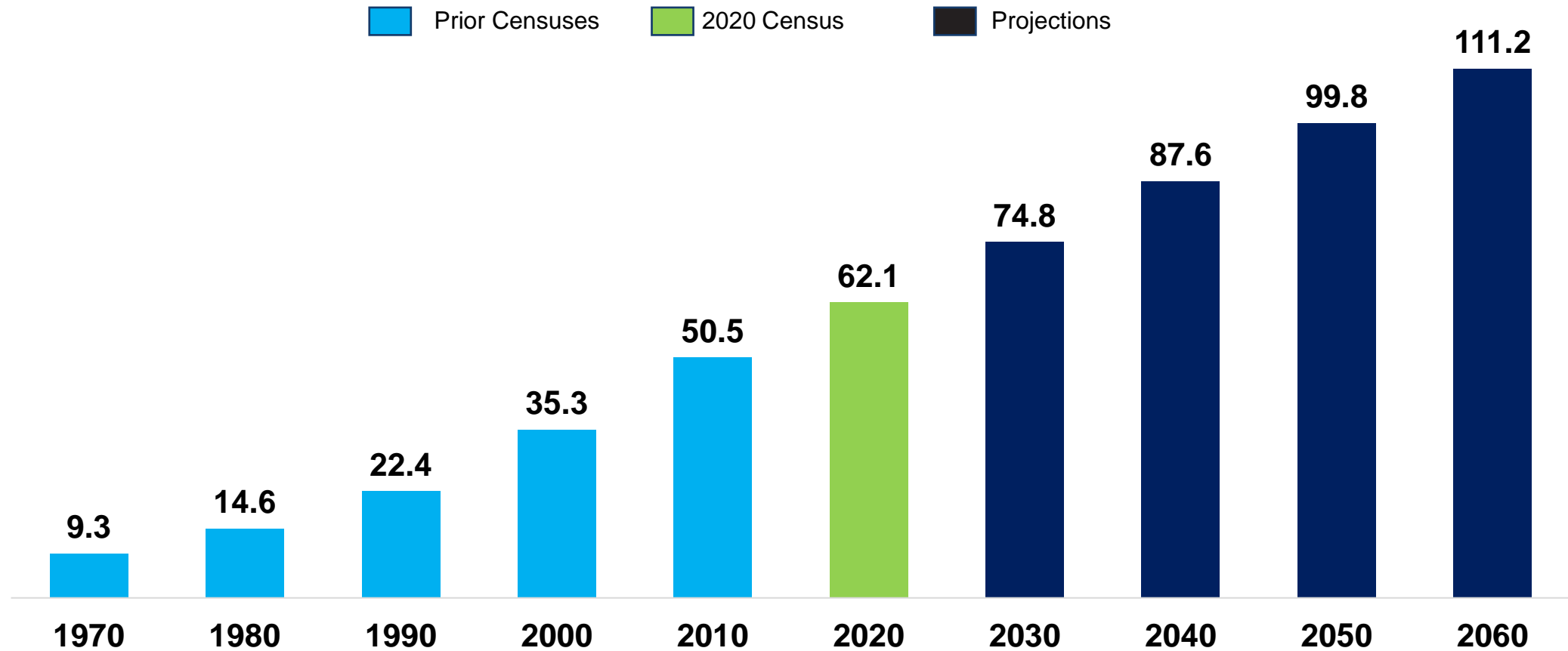

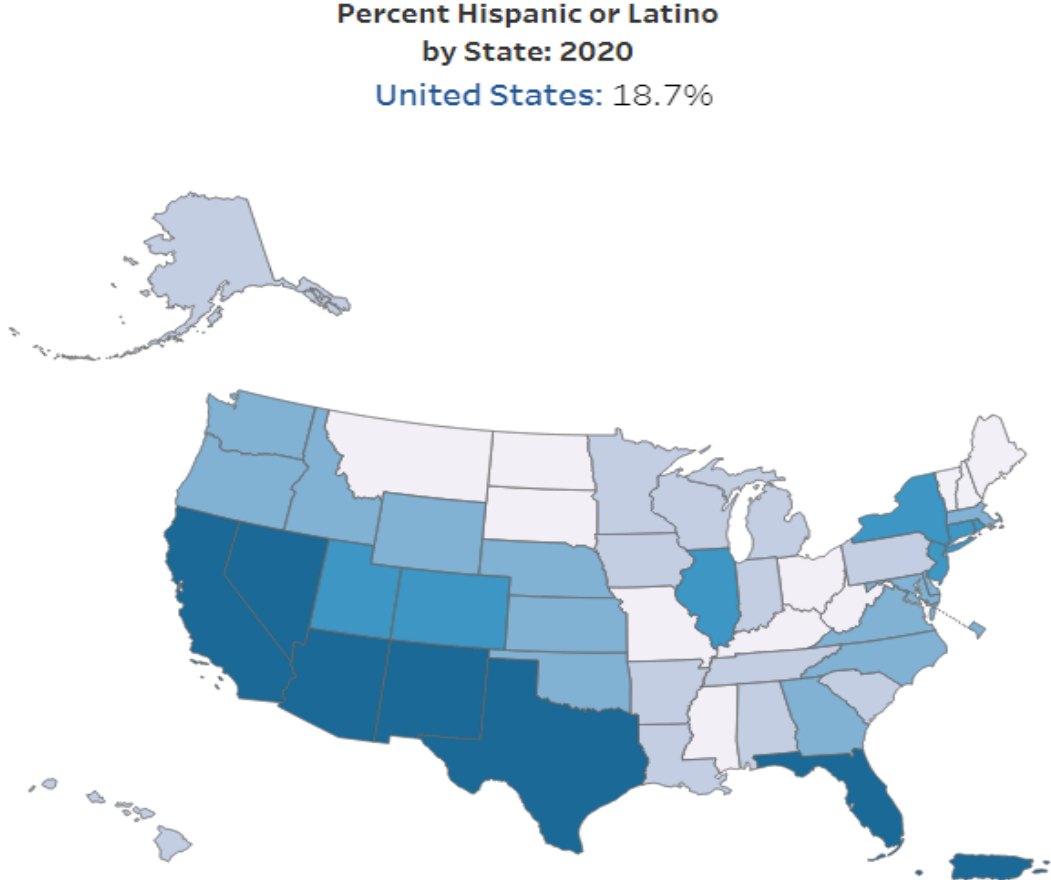
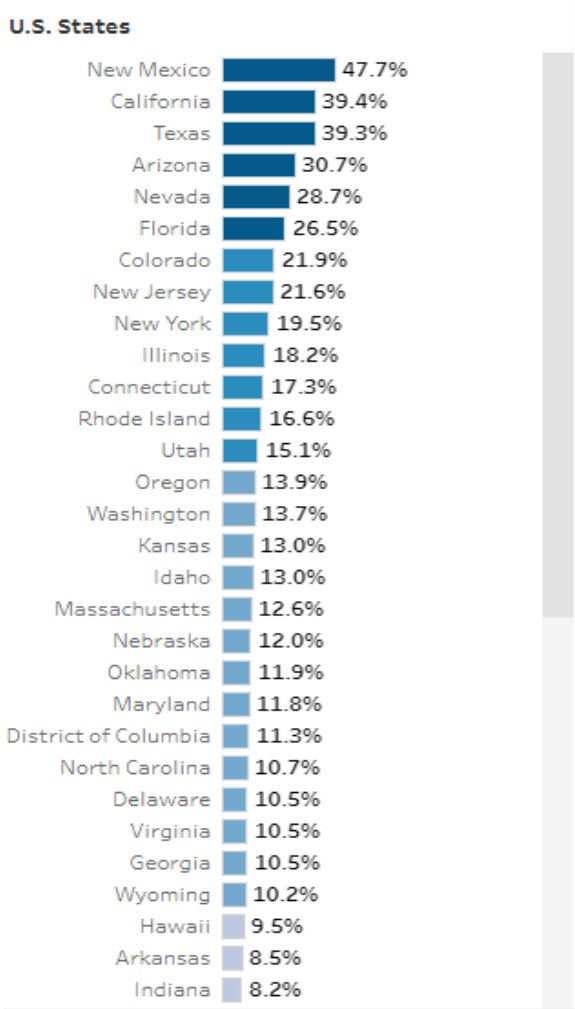

Population in millions



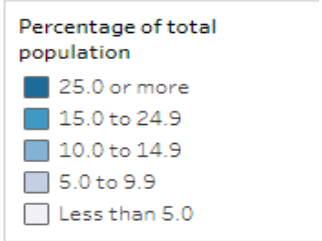
Percentage Hispanic or Latino by State: 2020



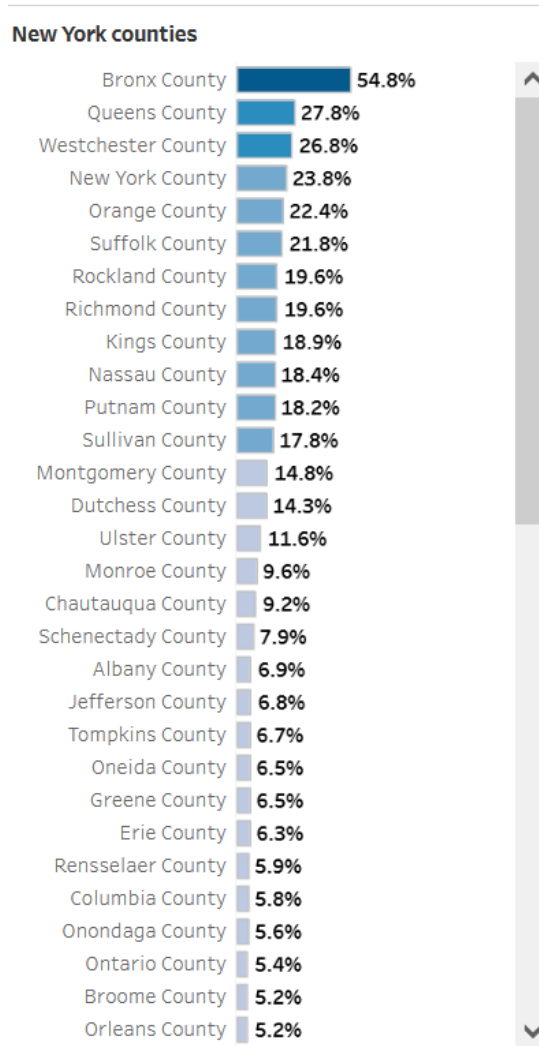

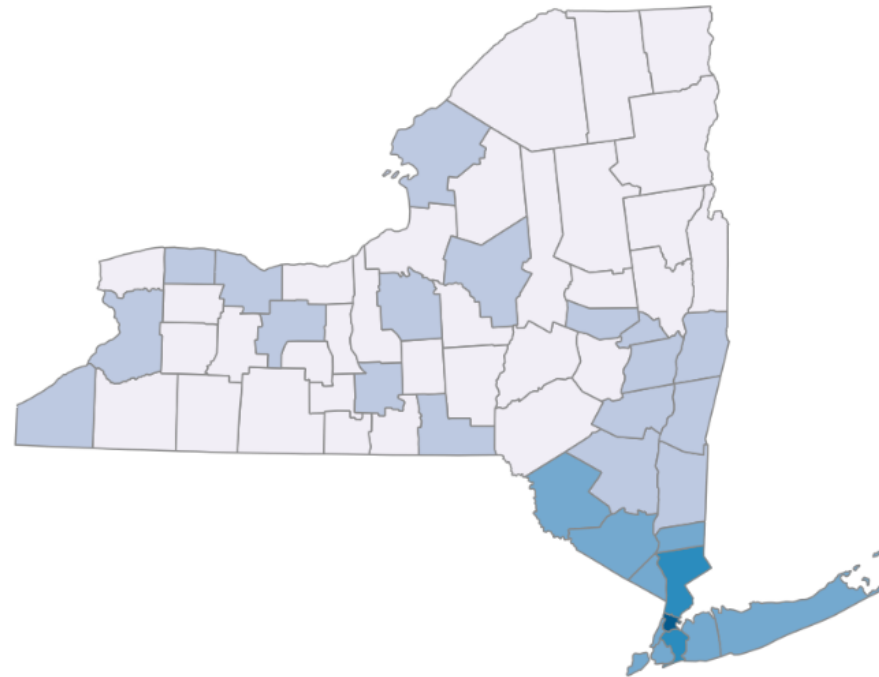


Percentage Hispanic or Latino by County: 2020

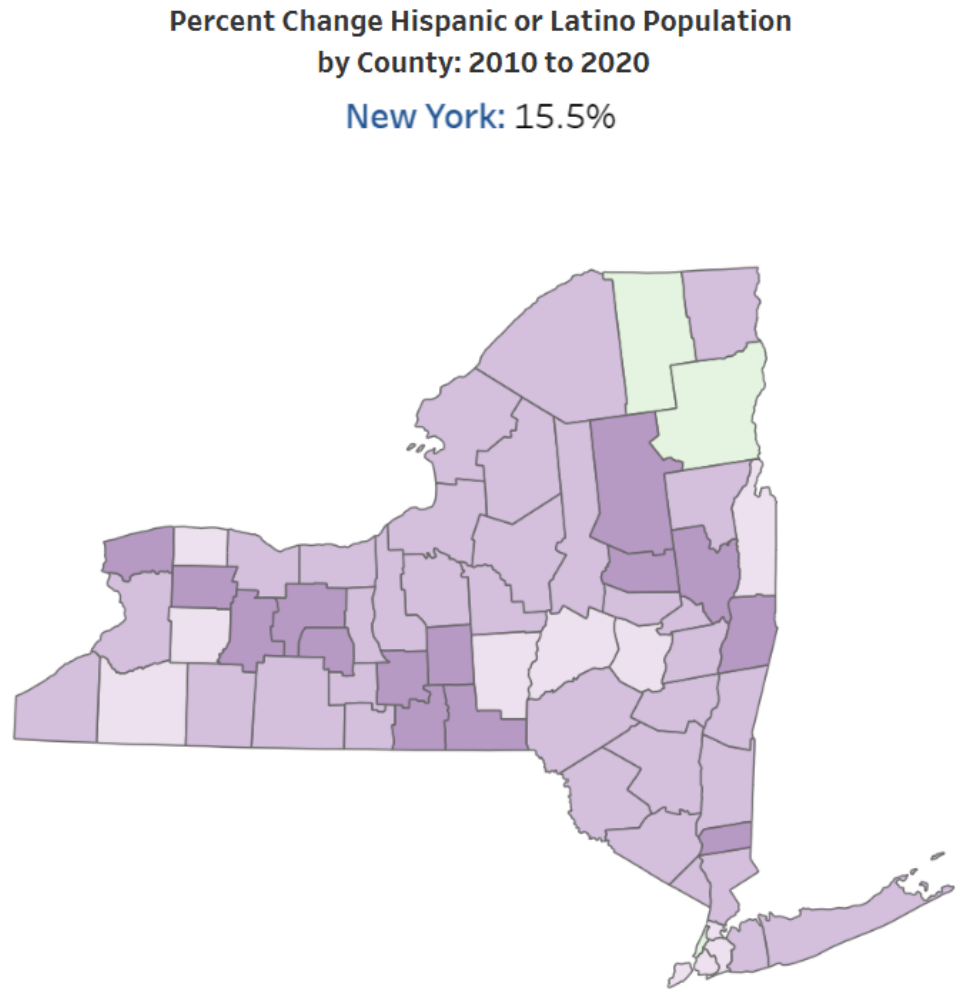

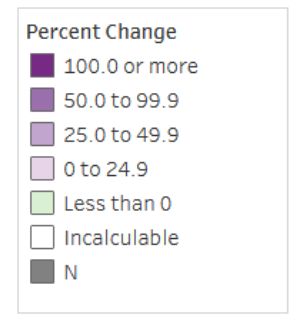

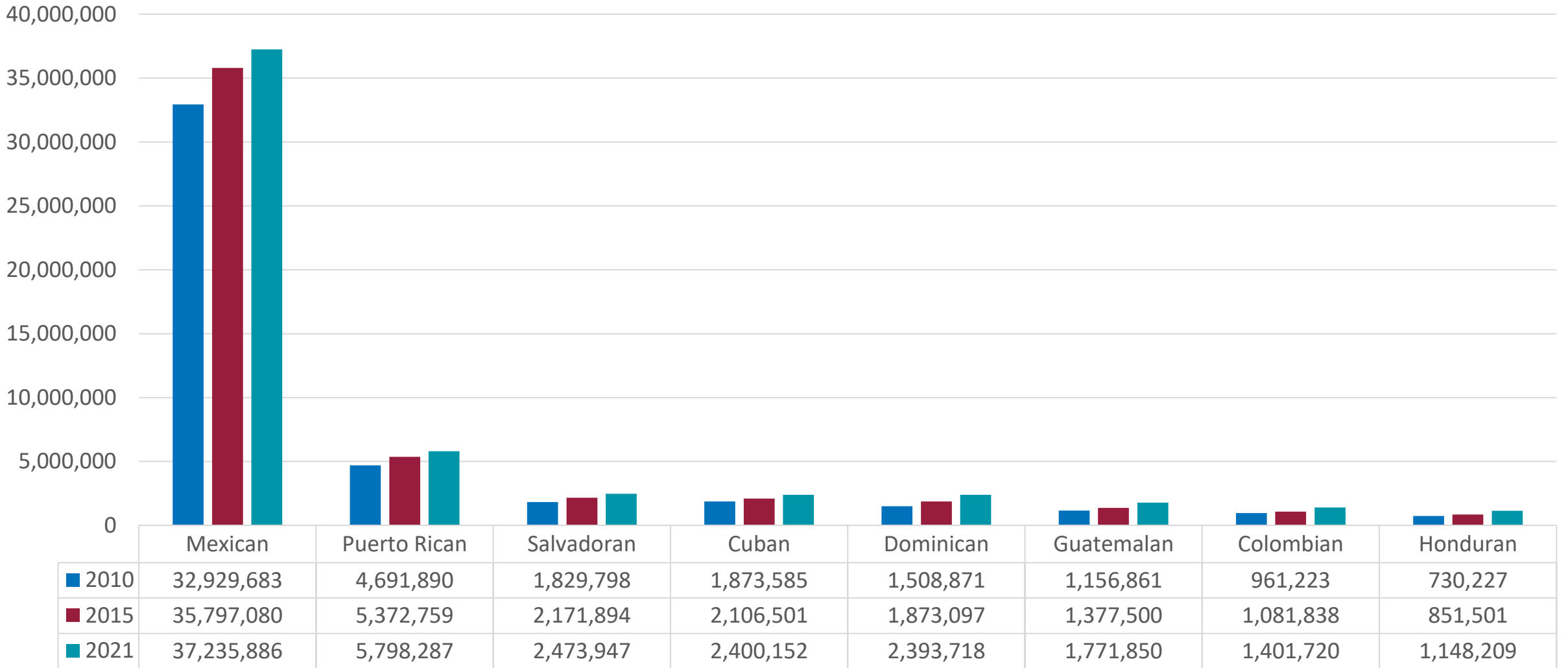

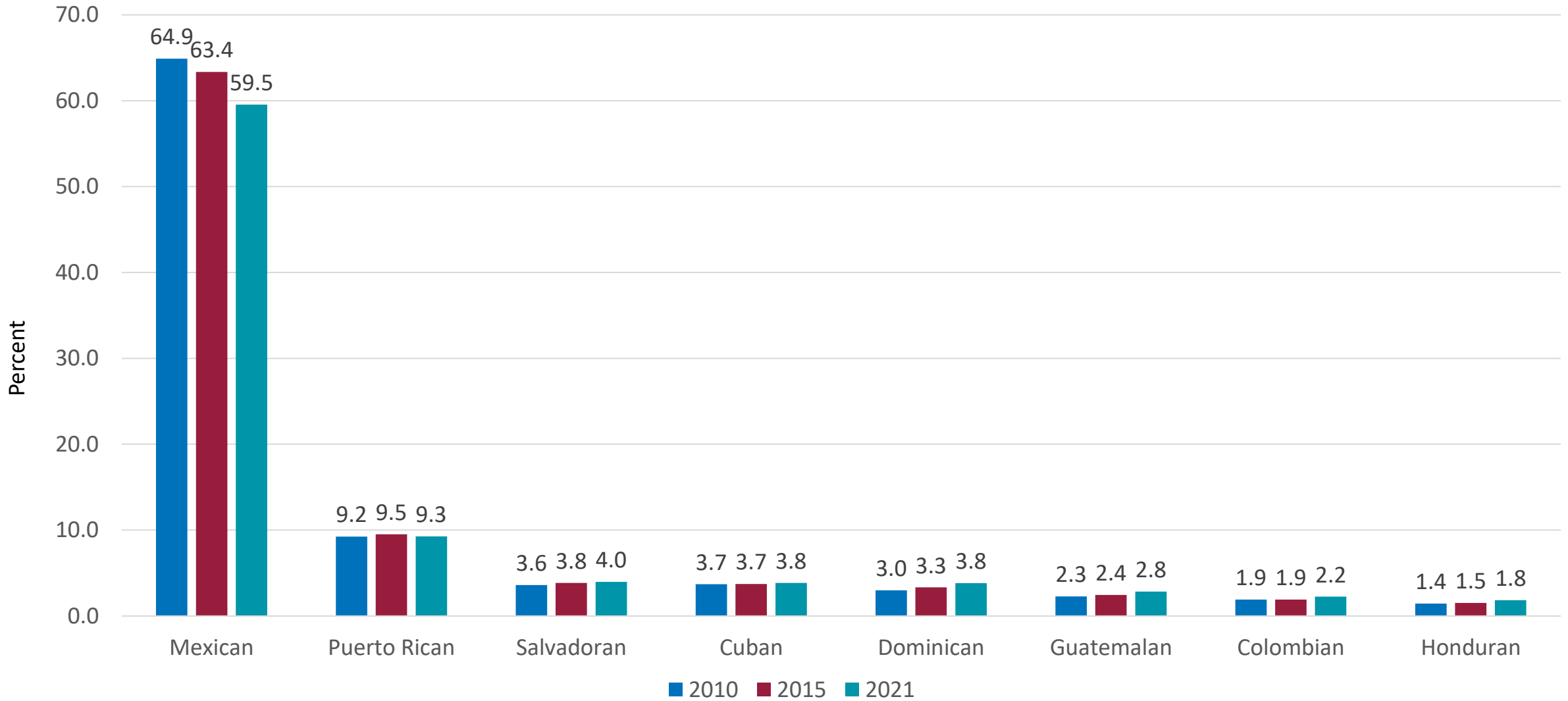

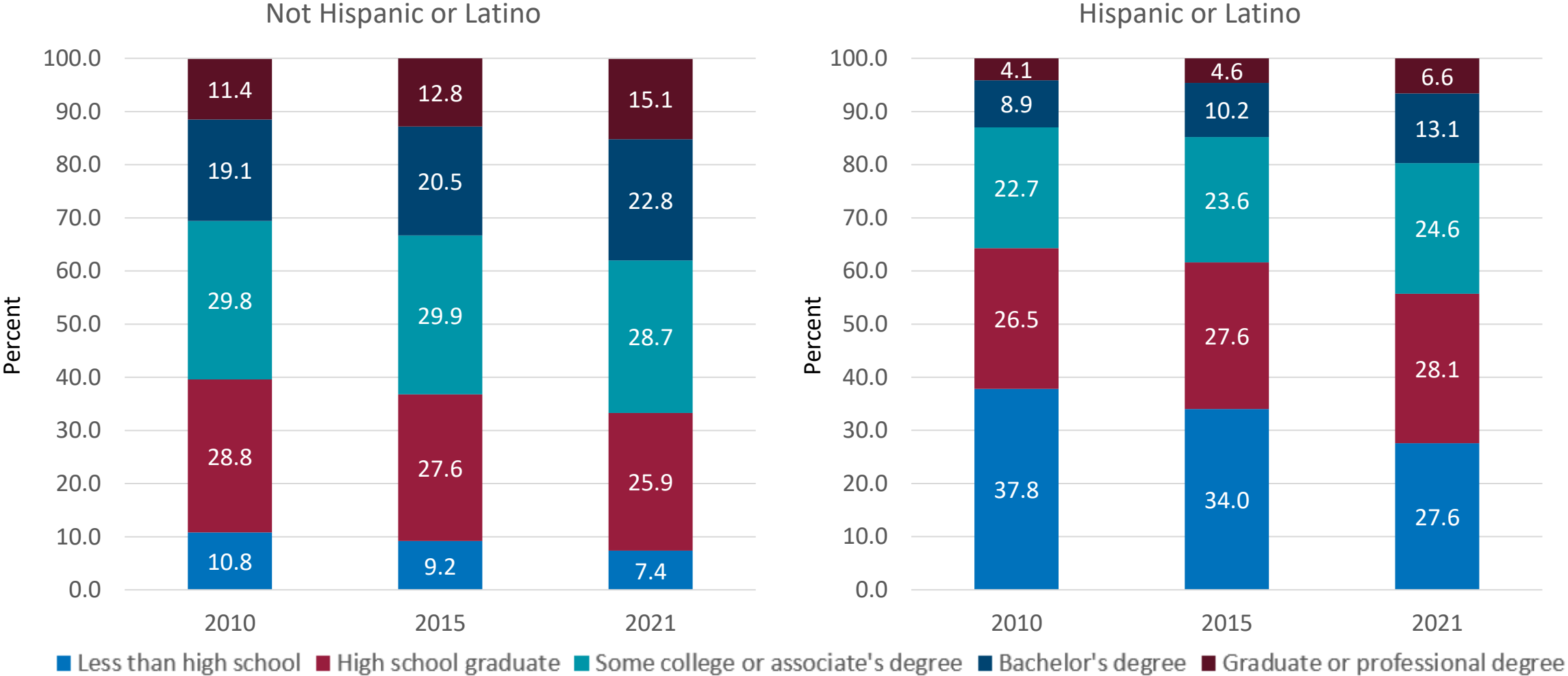
Hispanic Origin Groups with at Least One Million Population in 2021

Educational Attainment by Hispanic or Latino and Not Hispanic or Latino: Population 25 years and over

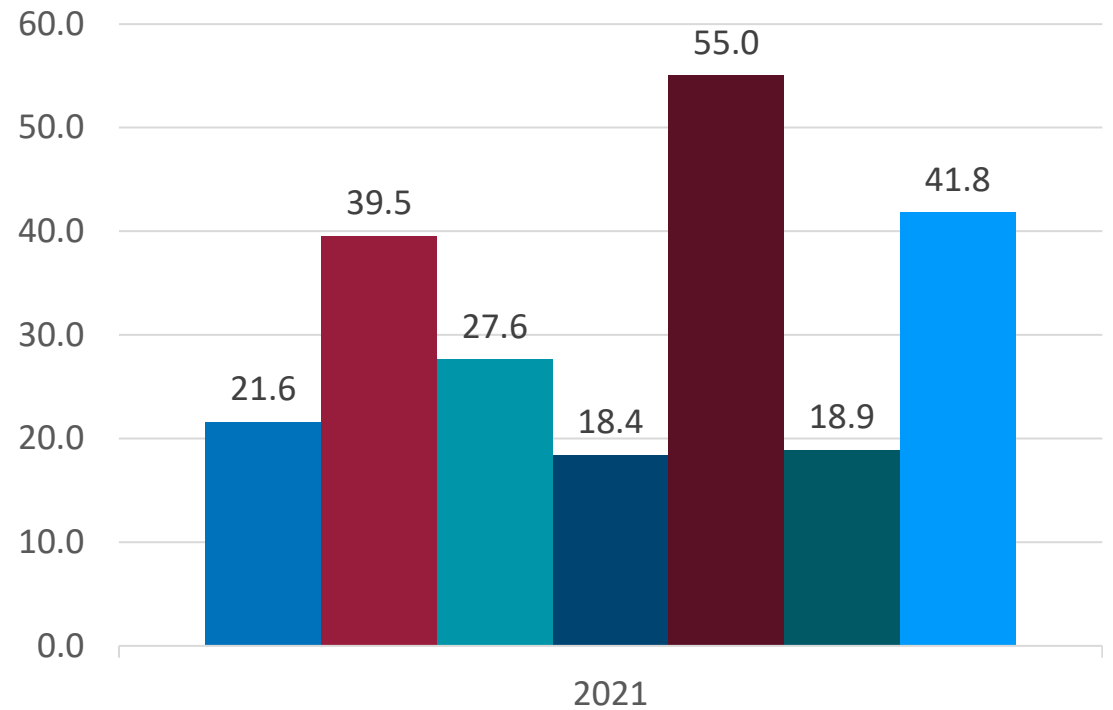
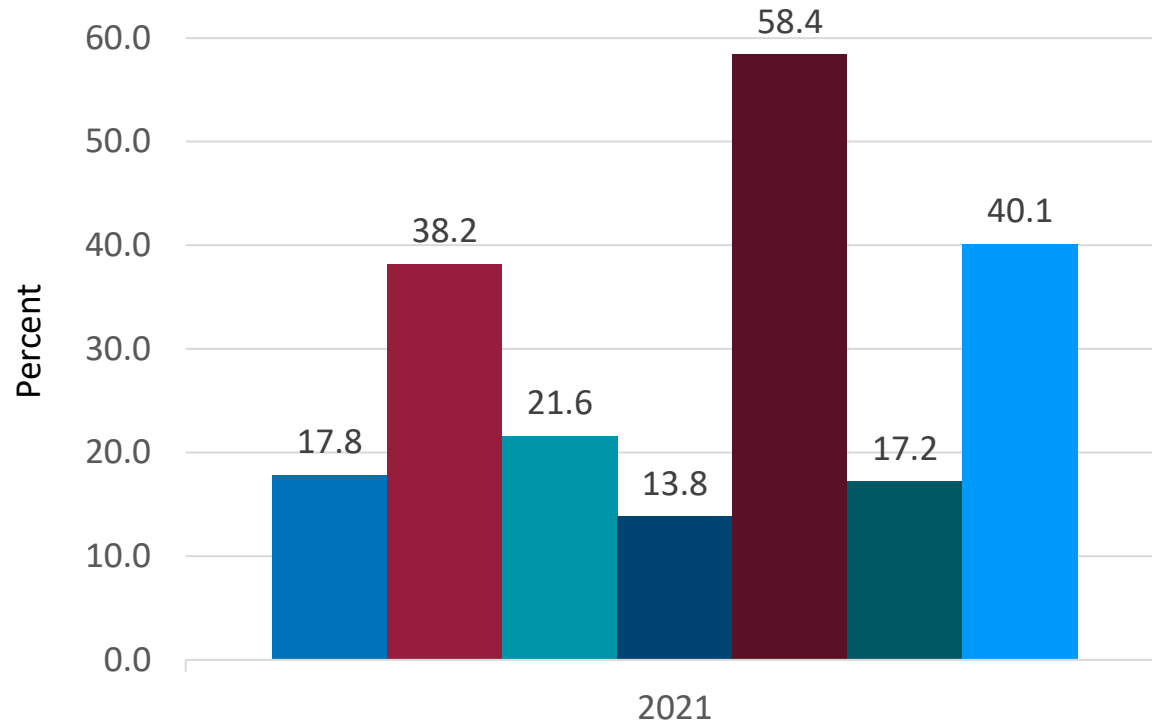

Population 25 years and over with a bachelor's degree or higher

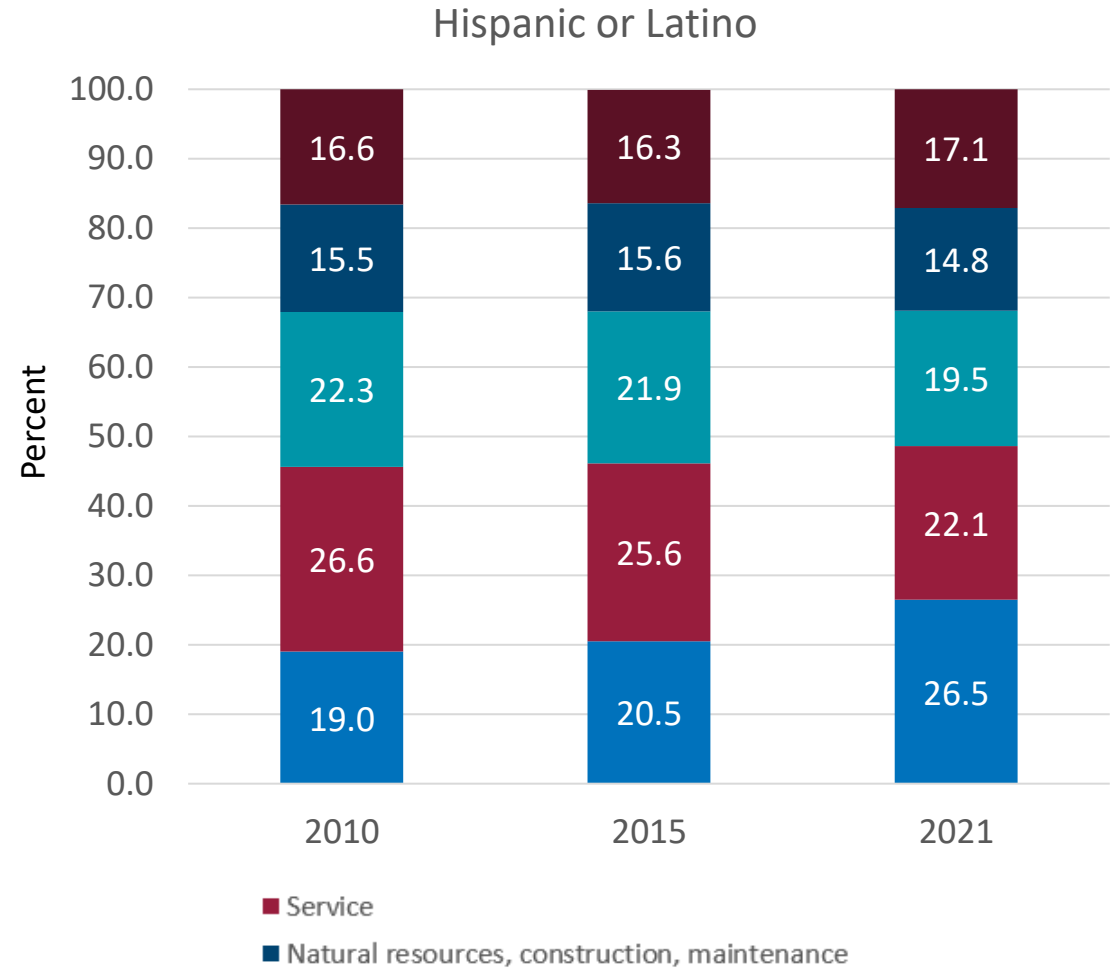
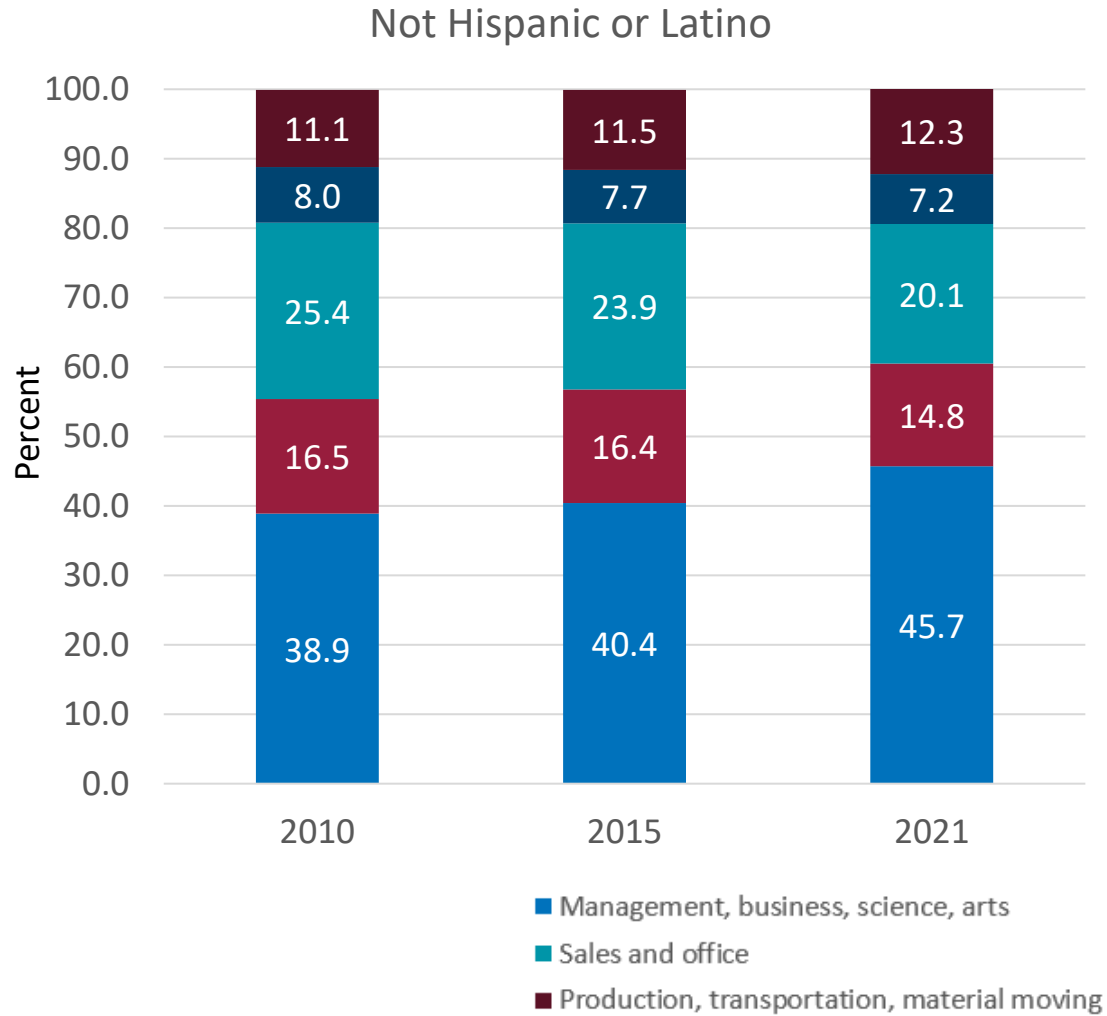

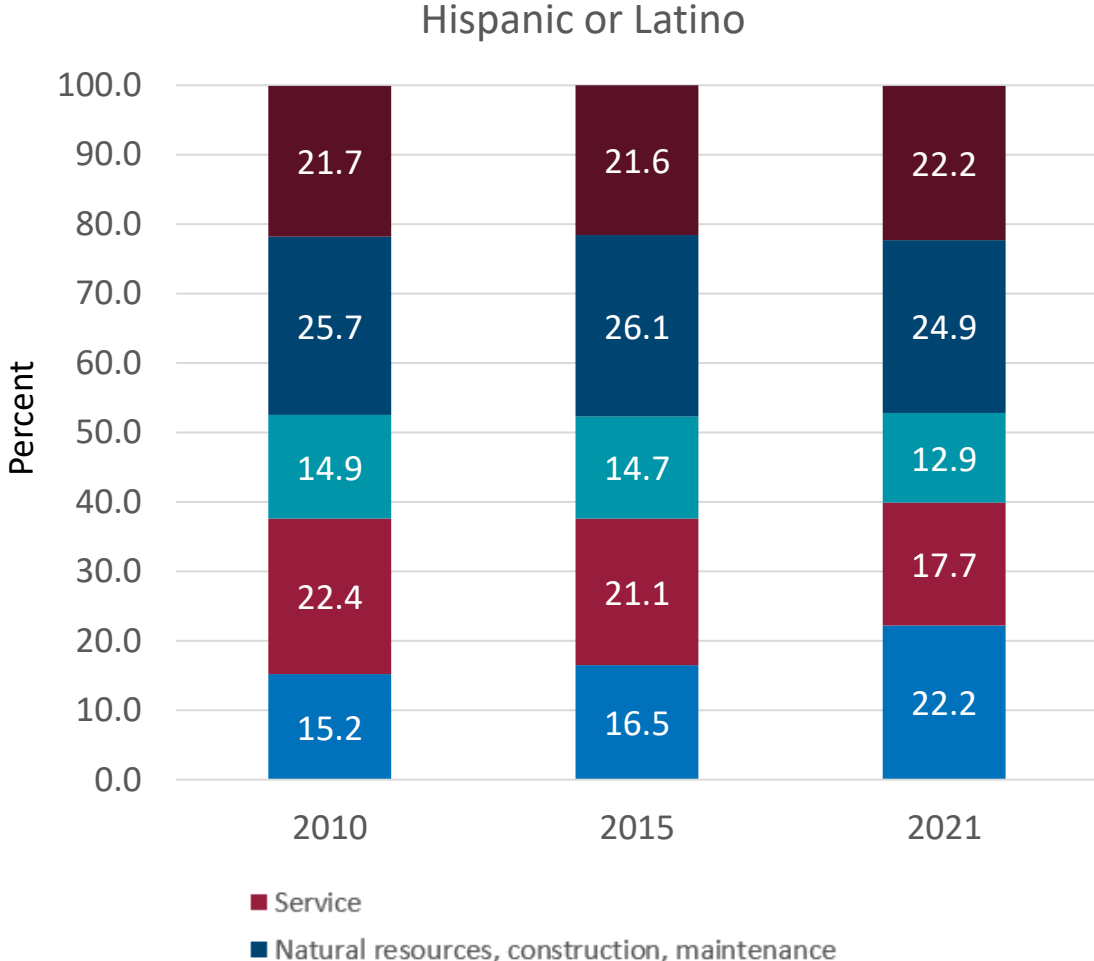
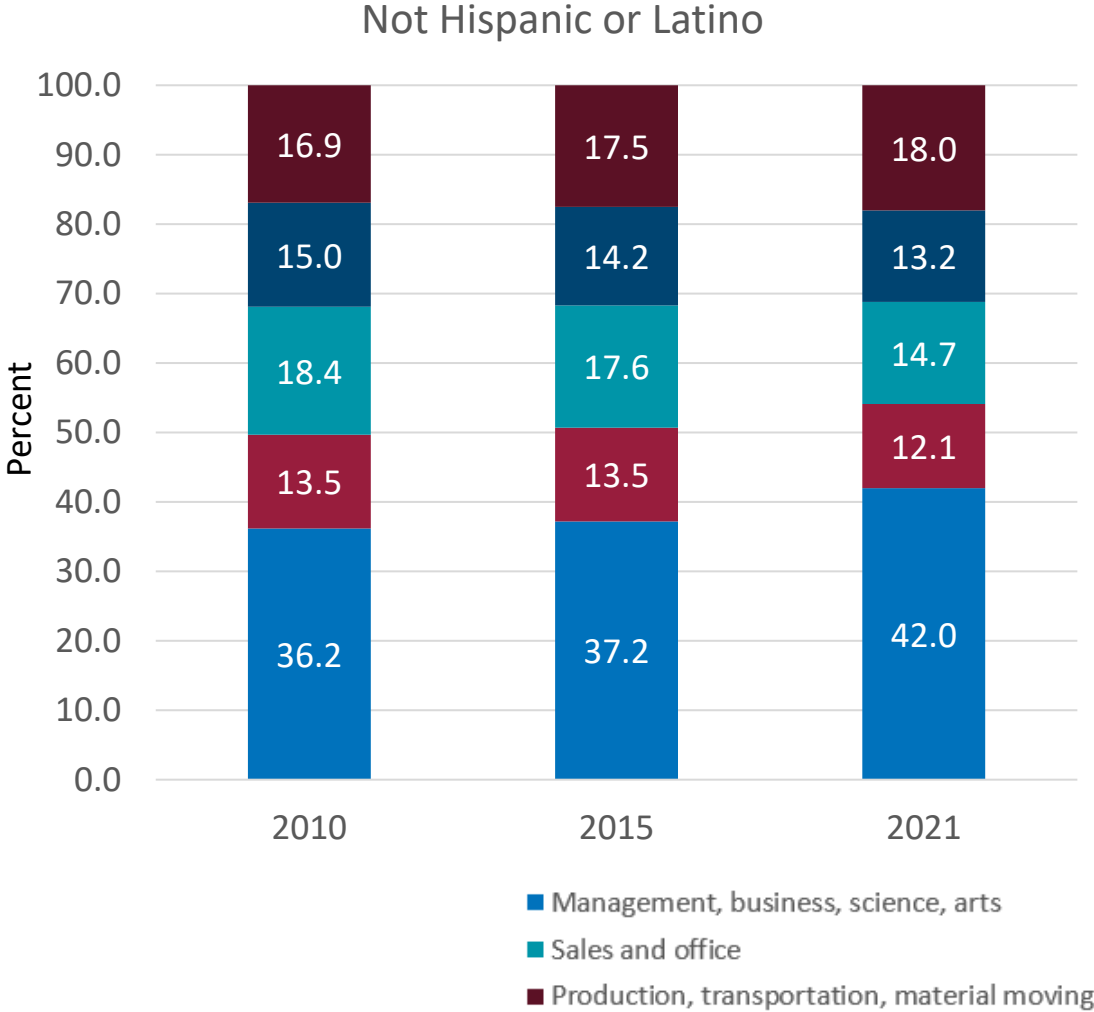

Occupation by Hispanic or Latino and Not Hispanic or Latino: Civilian Population 16 years and over

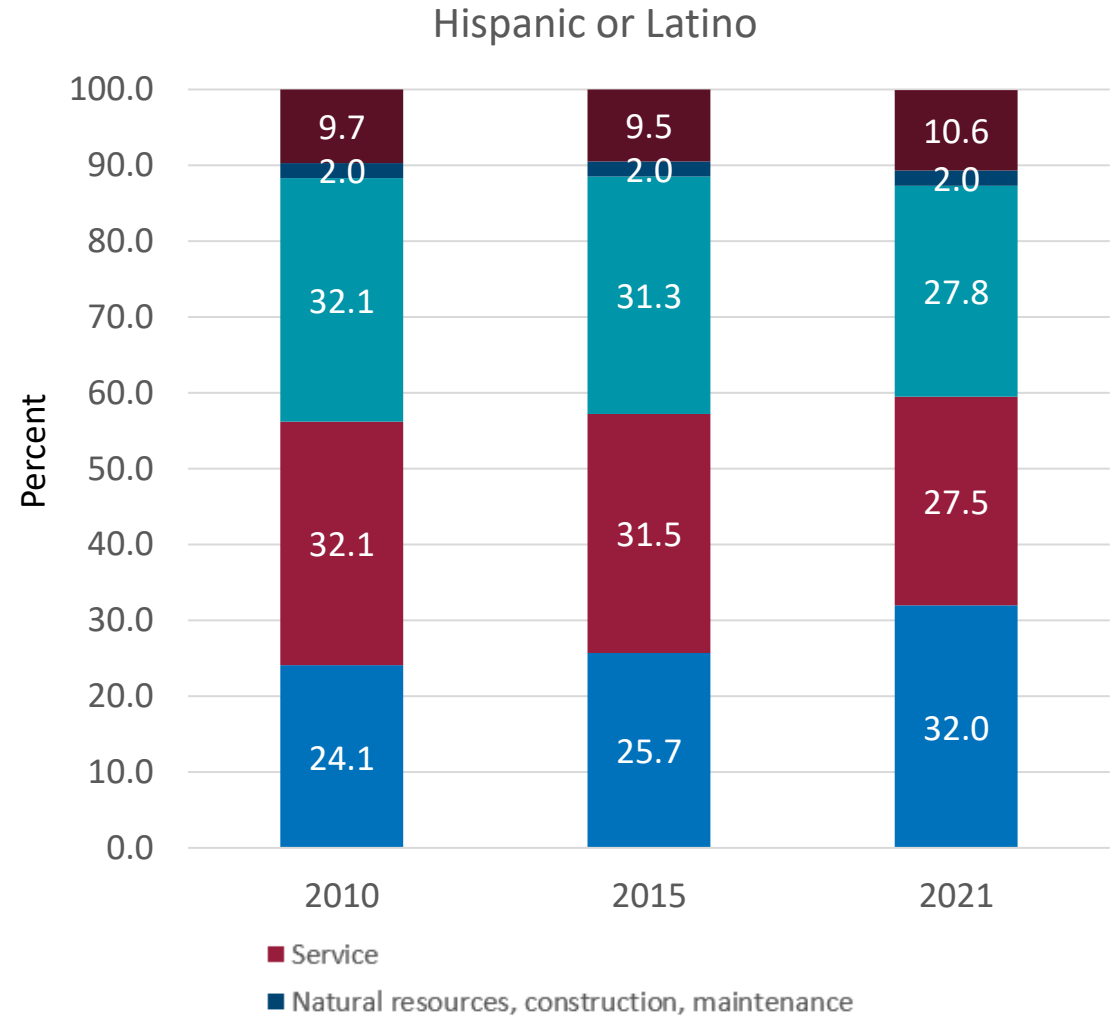
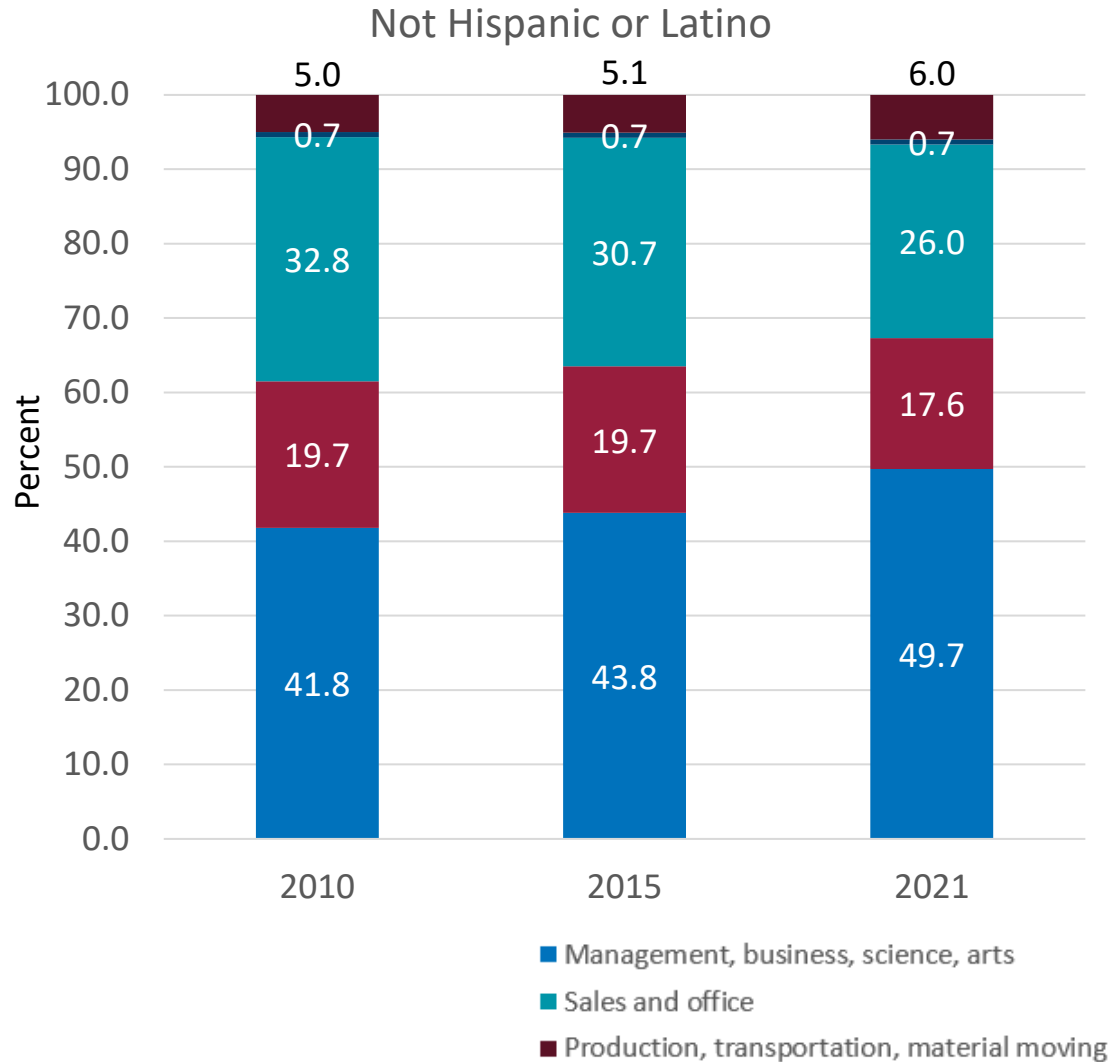


Occupation by Hispanic or Latino and Not Hispanic or Latino: Male Civilian Population 16 years and over



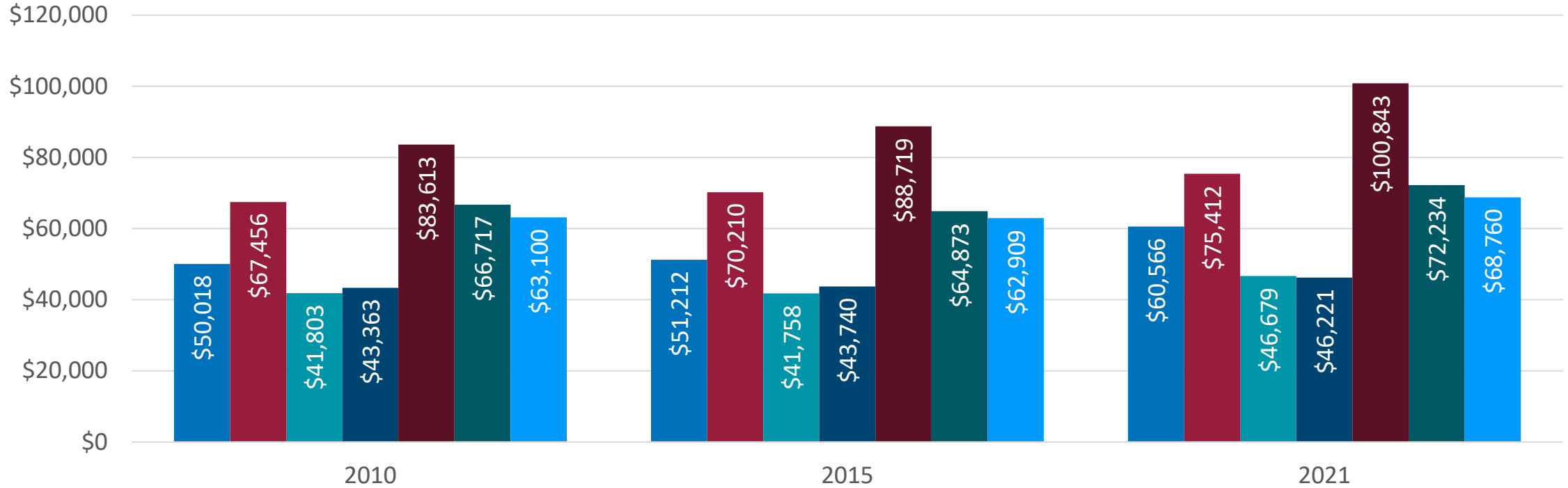

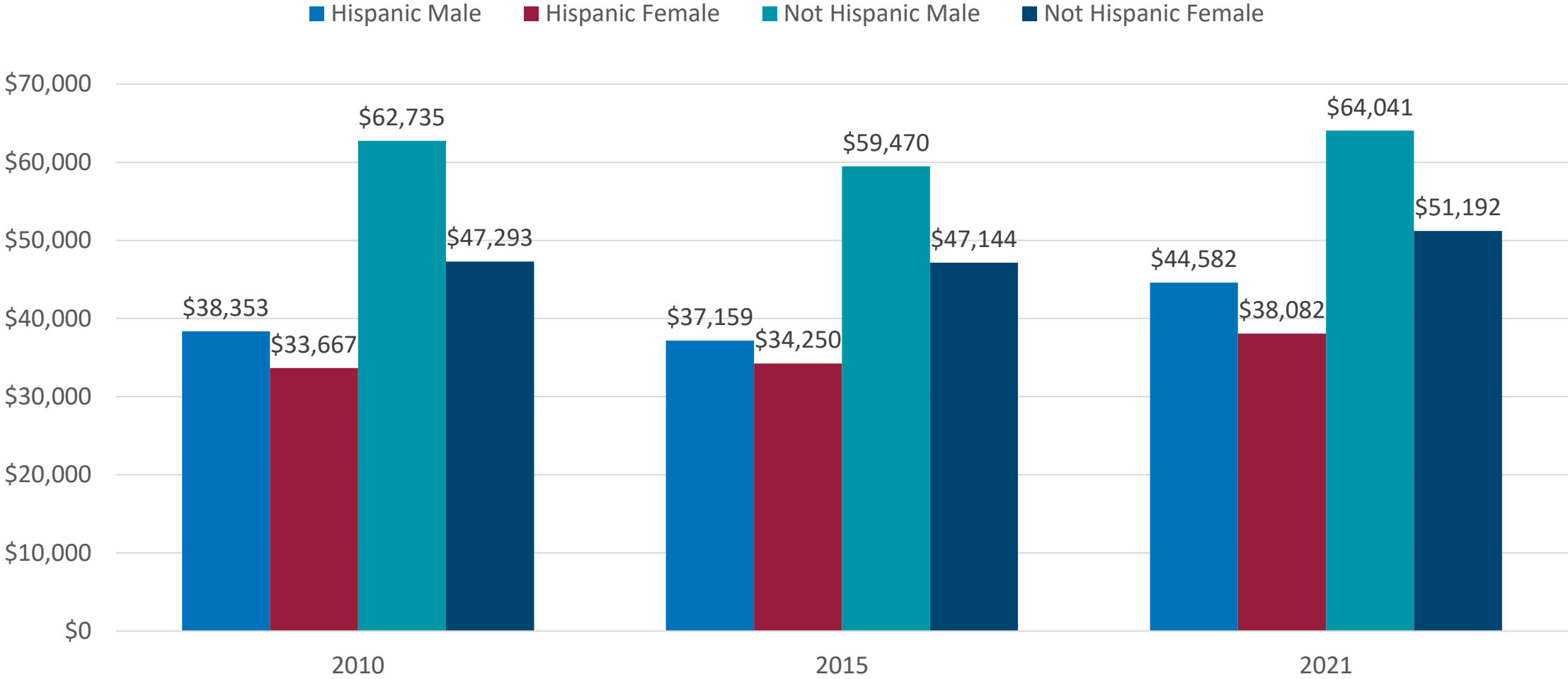

Median Earnings (dollars) full-time, year-round workers by Hispanic Origin and Sex: In 2021 Inflation-Adjusted Dollars

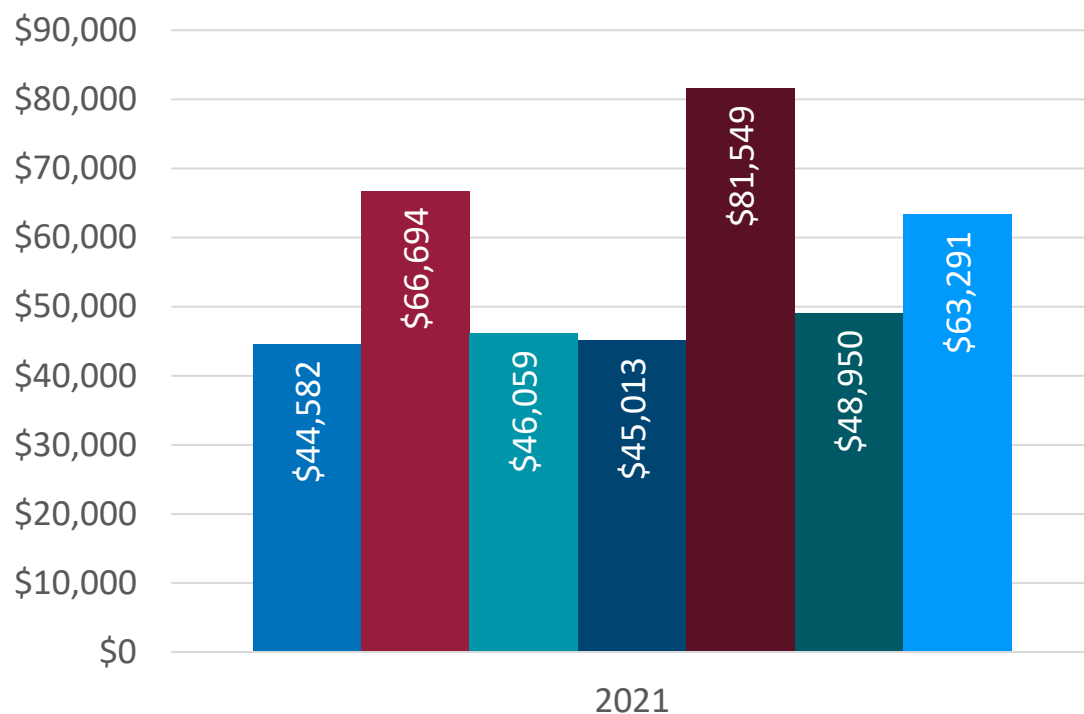

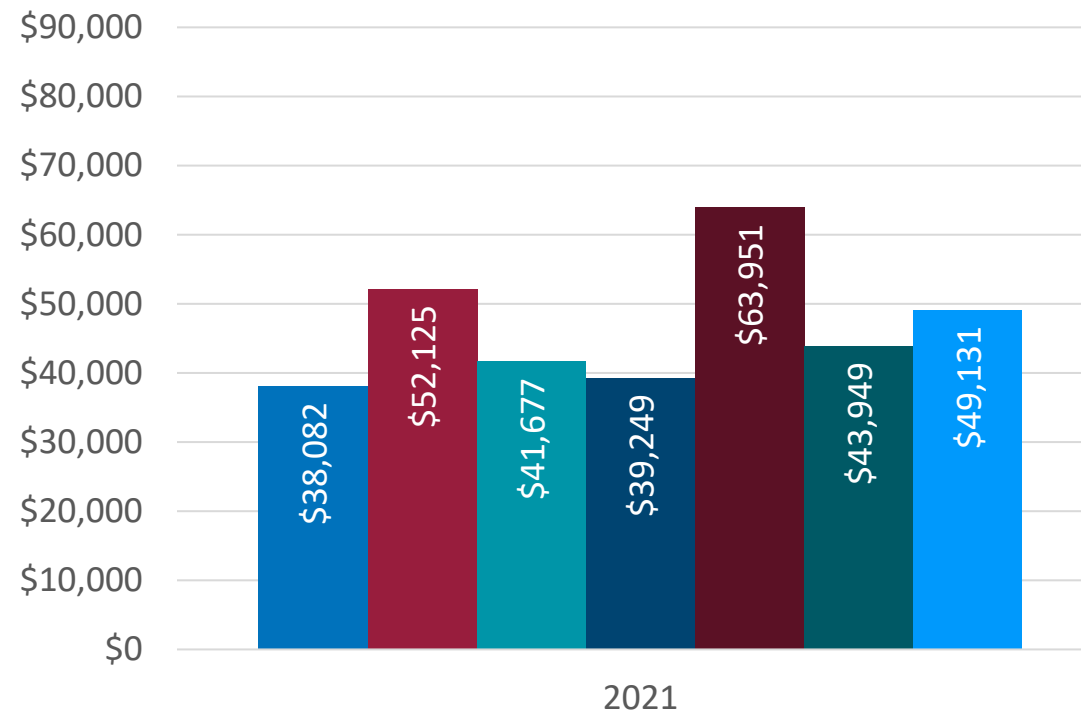
